## Cockatoo by Conni Hartig


material:
$100 \%$ cotton yarn, size 10 polyester fiberfill for stuffing black eyes
steel crochet hook size:
metric: 1,5mm, US: 8, UK: 4 1/2

## abbreviation:

$\mathrm{st}=$ stitch
$\mathrm{sc}=$ single crochet
slst= slip stitch
ch= chain
hdc= half double crochet
sc2tog $=$ work 2 single crochet together $\mathrm{R}=$ round

## Info:

This pattern is designed to be crocheted in continuous rounds - do no close rounds or turn unless otherwise stated. Mark the first stitch of each round.

## Head/body:

color: white

R 1: make 6 sc in a crochet ring: 6 sts
R 2: 2 sc in each st around: $\mathbf{1 2}$ sts
R 3: (1 sc, 2 sc in next st) around: 18 sts
next 2 rounds: 1 sc in each st around: 18 sts stuff
R 6: (1sc, sc2tog) around: 12 sts
R 7: (1 sc, 2 sc in next st) around: 18 sts
R 8: (1 sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st) around: $\mathbf{2 4}$ sts
next 4 rounds: 1 sc in each st around: $\mathbf{2 4}$ sts
R 13: (1 sc, 2 sc in next st) around: 18 sts
stuff
R 14: (1sc, sc2tog) around: 12 sts
R 16: (sc2tog) around: 6 sts
R 16: (sc2tog) around: 3 sts

## wings:

color: white
begin: work $4 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in each ch from second ch from hook: 3 sts
Row 1: turn the work (make $5 \mathrm{ch}, 1$ slst in each ch from second ch from hook, 1 sc in next st) repeat finish: with the end of yarn sew the wings on the body

## tail-feathers:

color: white
begin: work $5 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in each ch from second ch from hook: 4 sts
Row 1: turn the work, 1 slst in first st, make 7 ch, 1 hdc in the next 5 ch from second ch from hook, 1 slst in last ch, 1 slst next st,
make 7 ch, 1 hdc in the next 5 ch from second ch from hook, 1 slst in last ch, 1 slst next st, make 8 ch, 1 hdc in the next 6 ch from second ch from hook, 1 slst in last ch,
finish: with the end of yarn sew the tail-feathers on the body
leg: (make 3)
color: grey
make 3 ch

## completion:

embroider the bill on the head, sew the feathers on the body, pull in the eyes on the head or sew it on the head. Knot in the hairs
