material:

100% cotton yarn, size 10 polyester fiberfill for stuffing black eyes

steel crochet hook size: metric: 1,5mm, US: 8, UK: 4 1/2

abbreviation:

st= stitch
sc= single crochet
slst= slip stitch
ch= chain
hdc= half double crochet
sc2tog= work 2 single crochet together
R= round

Info:

This pattern is designed to be crocheted in continuous rounds - do no close rounds or turn unless otherwise stated. Mark the first stitch of each round.

Head/body: color: brown

R 1: make 6 sc in a crochet ring: 6 sts R 2: 2 sc in each st around: 12 sts

R 3: (1 sc, 2 sc in next st) around: 18 sts R 4: (2 sc, 2 sc in next st) around: 24 sts next 4 rounds: 1 sc in each st around: 24 sts

R 9: (2sc, sc2tog) around: 18 sts R 10: (1sc, sc2tog) around: 12 sts

stuff

R 11: (sc2tog) around: 6 sts

R 12: 2 sc in each st around: 12 sts

R 13: (1 sc, 2 sc in next st) around: 18 sts R 14: (2 sc, 2 sc in next st) around: 24 sts next 4 rounds: 1 sc in each st around: 24 sts

R 19: (2sc, sc2tog) around: 18 sts R 20: (1sc, sc2tog) around: 12 sts

stuff

R 11: (sc2tog) around: 6 sts

eyes: (make 2) color: white

R 1: make 6 sc in a crochet ring: 6 sts

close round with slst

wings:

color: brown

R 1: make 4 sc in a crochet ring: 4 sts
R 2: (1 sc, 2 sc in next st) around:6 sts
R 3: (1 sc, 2 sc in next st) around: 9 sts
R 4: (2 sc, 2 sc in next st) around: 12 sts
R 5: (3 sc, 2 sc in next st) around: 15 sts

finish: with the end of yarn sew the wings on the body

completion:

sew the eyes, embroider the beak on the head and embroider the feet \/\mathbb{I}\/\ on the bottom. sew the wings on the body, pull in the eyes on the head or sew it on the head. Knot in the ears
