material:

100% cotton yarn, size 10
polyester fiberfill for stuffing
black eyes
steel crochet hook size:
metric: 1,5mm, US: 8, UK: 4 1/2

abbreviation:

st= stitch
sc= single crochet
slst= slip stitch
ch= chain
hdc= half double crochet
sc2tog= work 2 single crochet together
R= round

Info:

This pattern is designed to be crocheted in continuous rounds - do no close rounds or turn unless otherwise stated. Mark the first stitch of each round.

Head/Body:

color: white or green/white/brown
for male start with green

R 1: make 6 sc in a crochet ring: **6 sts**
R 2: 2 sc in each st around: **12 sts**
R 3: (1 sc, 2 sc in next st) around: **18 sts**
R 4: (2 sc, 2 sc in next st) around: **24 sts**
next 4 rounds: 1 sc in each st around: **24 sts**
R 9: (2sc, sc2tog) around: **18 sts**
R 10: (1sc, sc2tog) around: **12 sts**
stuff
R 11: (sc2tog) around: **6 sts**
for male change to white
R 12: 2 sc in each st around: **12 sts**
for male change to brown
R 13: (1 sc, 2 sc in next st) around: **18 sts**
R 4: (2 sc, 2 sc in next st) around: **24 sts**
next 4 rounds: 1 sc in each st around: **24 sts**
R 9: (2sc, sc2tog) around: **18 sts**
R 10: (1sc, sc2tog) around: **12 sts**
stuff
R 11: (sc2tog) around: **6 sts**

wings: (make 2)

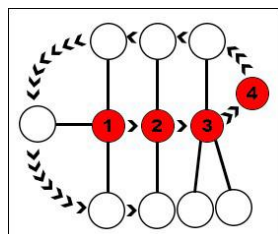
color: white or brown
R 1: make 6 sc in a crochet ring: **6 sts**
R 2: 2 sc in each st around: **12 sts**
next 2 rounds: 1 sc in each st around: **12 sts**
R 5: (4sc, sc2tog) around: **10 sts**
fold together and crochet together

tail:

color: white or brown
R 1: make 6 sc in a crochet ring: **6 sts**
R 2: (1 sc, 2 sc in next st) around: **9 sts**
R 3: (2 sc, 2 sc in next st) around: **12 sts**

feet: (make 2)

color: yellow
R 1: make 6 sc in a crochet ring: **6 sts**
R 2: (1 sc, 2 sc in next st) around: **9 sts**
next 2 rounds: 1 sc in each st around: **9 sts**
fold together and crochet through both stitches
make 3x (1hdc, 1 slst in next st)



O= ch, O= sc

beak:

color: yellow
begin: make 4 ch, 1sc in the next 2 ch from second ch from hook, 3sc in the last ch, working on opposite side of beginning chain stitch: sc in next ch, 2sc in last ch: **8 sts**
R 2: 2 sc in each, 1 sc in next, 2 sc in next 3 st, 1 sc in next st, 2 sc in next 2 st: **14 sts**
close with slst
